Content	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Industrial Attachment</li> </ul> <p>The Industrial Attachment (IA) is a short-term (6 months) work experience for students to have an opportunity to put into practice their skills which they have acquired into the real-world workplace. This allows students to gain valuable real-life experience while working under the supervision of a full time employee thus learning a variety of skills. A variety of skills that can be applied may include teamwork, analytical skills and knowledge acquired while in school.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Project</li> </ul> <p>This module will introduce the students to developing a research idea and Outline and critically analyse key debates/theories/views associated with the chosen topic. The students will have to select a particular topic of their choice in consultation with the lecturer from the given choices. They are expected to develop research questions and effectively apply statistical techniques (as and when appropriate). They may also use secondary research to arrive at the conclusions and recommendations. It will help the students to Identify and access a range of appropriate academic and other information sources. The module develops the skill to effectively link empirical evidence to theory, generating conclusions which are clearly linked to the hypothesis/ research question.</p>
