



Vietnam Market Scholarship Scheme 2026

The Vietnam Market Scholarship Scheme is a nationality-based scholarship initiative introduced by Amity Global Institute to support eligible students from Vietnam across selected foundation, diploma, advanced diploma, bachelor's top-up and postgraduate programmes. The scholarship is designed to improve access to higher education by providing tuition fee subsidies for Vietnamese students, with scholarship values varying according to the programme of study.

1. Scholarship Coverage

The scholarship provides **tuition fee support only** and does not cover non-tuition fees, application fees, GST or other ancillary charges. Depending on the programme, the scholarship may be provided as:

- a) A **50% tuition fee scholarship** for the Foundation Diploma programme and the Diploma and Advanced Diploma programmes in Business Administration or Computing.
- b) A **fixed tuition fee scholarship amount** for selected programmes, as follows:
- c) Diploma in Hospitality Operations and Management: **Scholarship of S\$500 (tuition fee only)**
- d) Advanced Diploma in Hospitality and Operations Management: **Scholarship of S\$2,000 (tuition fee only)**
- e) Bachelor of Arts (Hons) Global Communication with Business Management (Top-up) (Teach-out): **Scholarship of S\$5,000 (tuition fee only)**
- f) Bachelor of Science (Honours) Computing Science with Software Development (Top-up) (Teach-out): **Scholarship of S\$2,500 (tuition fee only)**
- g) Bachelor of Arts (Honours) International Tourism Management (Top-up) (Teach-out): **Scholarship of S\$2,500 (tuition fee only)**
- h) Bachelor of Arts (Honours) International Business Management (Top-up) (Teach-out): **Scholarship of S\$5,000 (tuition fee only)**
- i) Master of Science International Management: **Scholarship of S\$7,000 (tuition fee only)**
- j) Master of Science Applied Data Science: **Scholarship of S\$7,000 (tuition fee only)**



- k) Master of Science Applied Artificial Intelligence: **Scholarship of S\$7,000 (tuition fee only)**
- l) A **100% tuition fee scholarship** for the University of Northampton (UON) Master of Business Administration upon progression from the Amity Postgraduate Diploma in Management, in accordance with the approved scholarship scheme.

Payment Schedule and Scholarship Disbursement

The scholarship will be applied as a tuition fee credit only and will be disbursed progressively against the tuition fee instalments due under the Student Contract. Each scholarship credit will be applied at the same intervals as the applicable tuition fee payment schedule, subject to the Student remaining eligible for the scholarship on the date of each disbursement. The scholarship will not be paid directly to the Student in cash.

The Student must make all payments by the due dates stated in the Student Contract, including any portion of the tuition fee not covered by the scholarship and all application fees, non-tuition fees, miscellaneous fees, GST and other applicable charges. The scholarship does not postpone, suspend or replace the Student's payment obligations under the Student Contract.

Scholarship Validity and Duration

The scholarship offer is valid until 31 March 2027 and applies only to the approved programme and intake stated in the scholarship approval or offer. To secure the scholarship, the Student must accept the offer, satisfy all admission and scholarship eligibility requirements, execute the Student Contract, and complete the required enrolment and payment steps within the deadlines stated in the offer and no later than 31 March 2027.

Once activated, the scholarship will apply for the normal duration of the approved programme as stated in the Student Contract, subject to the Student's continued compliance with all scholarship conditions. It will not automatically extend to a deferred intake, repeated module, resit, repeat assessment, leave of absence, programme extension or any period beyond the normal programme duration unless the Institute gives prior written approval.



Scholarship Expiry or Lapsing

The scholarship offer will automatically expire or lapse if any of the following occurs before the scholarship is activated:

- a) The Student does not accept the scholarship offer or complete the required enrolment formalities by 31 March 2027 or by any earlier deadline stated in the offer.
- b) The Student does not enrol in or commence the approved programme and intake, is recorded as a no-show, or declines or cancels the offer.
- c) The Student fails to satisfy the admission or scholarship eligibility requirements, provide valid supporting documents, execute the Student Contract or make any required payment by the applicable deadline.
- d) The Student transfers, defers or changes the approved programme, intake or study mode without the Institute's prior written approval.
- e) The basis on which the scholarship was offered ceases to apply before programme commencement, including where the Student no longer qualifies under the Vietnam Market Scholarship Scheme.

Expiry or lapsing of the scholarship is distinct from withdrawal after programme commencement. Once expired or lapsed, the scholarship has no cash, refund or credit value and will not be reinstated automatically. Any reinstatement or fresh application is subject to the Institute's written approval, availability of the scholarship scheme and the terms prevailing at that time.

2. Scholarship Eligibility and Conditions

By accepting the scholarship, the Student agrees that the award and its continued retention are subject to the following terms and conditions:

- a) The Student must submit valid academic results and all required supporting documents during the admission application process. All information and documents submitted must be complete, accurate and authentic, and may be verified by the Institute.
- b) The Student must satisfy the admission requirements for the approved programme and receive formal written confirmation of the scholarship from Amity Global Institute. Admission to a programme does not, by itself, guarantee a scholarship award.



- c) The scholarship is available only to approved applicants holding Vietnamese nationality under the Vietnam Market Scholarship Scheme.
- d) The scholarship applies only to the programme and intake stated in the scholarship approval or offer and is non-transferable to another person, programme, intake or institution. Any transfer, deferment, change of intake, change of study mode or leave of absence requires the Institute's prior written approval and may result in reassessment of the scholarship.
- e) The scholarship applies only to tuition fees. It has no cash value and cannot be exchanged, assigned, refunded or converted into a credit for any other purpose. Application fees, non-tuition fees, miscellaneous fees, GST and other ancillary charges remain payable by the Student.
- f) Unless the Institute approves otherwise in writing, the scholarship cannot be combined with another scholarship, bursary, grant, sponsorship, discount, promotion or fee waiver. Where more than one benefit may apply, the Institute will determine the applicable award.
- g) The Student must remain enrolled in the approved programme, maintain active student status and, where applicable, maintain a valid immigration or student pass throughout the period of study.
- h) The Student must comply with all academic and attendance requirements, including maintaining a minimum overall attendance rate of 90% or any higher requirement prescribed by the Institute or applicable authority.
- i) The Student must complete and submit all assignments, assessments and coursework within the stipulated deadlines, unless an extension has been formally approved in accordance with the Institute's policies.
- j) The Student must pass every module on the first attempt. A resit, repeat assessment or repeat module may trigger a review and possible withdrawal of the scholarship.
- k) The Student must comply at all times with the Student Contract, academic integrity requirements, codes of conduct, policies, rules and regulations of Amity Global Institute, as amended from time to time.
- l) The Student must pay all tuition fees not covered by the scholarship and all other fees and charges by the prescribed due dates, and must promptly notify the Institute of any change in circumstances that may affect scholarship eligibility.



3. Withdrawal, Suspension or Discontinuation of Scholarship

The Institute may suspend, review, withdraw or discontinue the scholarship where the Student fails to satisfy the eligibility requirements or continuing conditions, including in any of the following circumstances:

- a) The Student breaches any scholarship condition or ceases to meet the eligibility criteria.
- b) Any information or supporting document submitted by or on behalf of the Student is false, misleading, incomplete, altered, forged or fraudulently obtained, or a material fact affecting eligibility has not been disclosed.
- c) The Student fails to meet the required academic performance, first-attempt pass, attendance, assignment, assessment or coursework requirements without an approved exception.
- d) The Student commits academic misconduct, serious misconduct or a disciplinary offence, or materially breaches the Student Contract or the Institute's policies, rules or regulations.
- e) The Student transfers, defers, changes intake or study mode, takes leave of absence, withdraws from the programme, has enrolment terminated, or otherwise ceases to hold active student status without the Institute's prior written approval.
- f) The Student fails to pay any tuition fee, non-tuition fee or other amount due after being notified of the outstanding payment.
- g) The Student's circumstances change in a manner that invalidates the basis on which the scholarship was awarded.

Review and decision

Before making a final decision, the Institute will review the relevant circumstances and may request a written explanation or supporting evidence. The Student may submit representations within the stated timeframe, and approved medical, compassionate or other exceptional circumstances may be considered. The decision will be communicated in writing, without prejudice to any grievance or appeal rights under the Institute's policies.

Financial consequences

If the scholarship is withdrawn or discontinued, the unapplied award will be cancelled from the effective date stated in the written notice. The Student's account may be



recalculated using the applicable standard tuition fee, and the full outstanding tuition fee, including any difference from the scholarship-adjusted fee, may become payable. Where withdrawal results from fraud, forgery, misrepresentation or material non-disclosure, previously applied scholarship amounts may also be recovered, subject to the Student Contract and applicable law. Any revised payment schedule will be communicated in writing.

Withdrawal or discontinuation does not, by itself, entitle the Student to a refund; any refund will be determined under the Student Contract, the Institute's refund policy and applicable regulatory requirements.

Reinstatement

A withdrawn or discontinued scholarship will not be reinstated automatically. Any reinstatement requires the Institute's written approval and may be subject to additional conditions.

4. General Provisions

- a) The scholarship award is personal to the Student and is subject to the terms stated in the scholarship approval, offer letter, Student Contract and this scheme document.
- b) The Institute may review or revise the scholarship scheme for future intakes. An existing approved award will continue to be governed by its written terms unless a change is required by law, a regulatory authority or the awarding institution.
- c) Any mandatory legal or regulatory requirement will prevail over a conflicting provision of this scheme, while the remaining provisions will continue to apply.
